◆ **Basic Academic Criteria:**

Freshmen (Rising Sophomores)

Declared Supply Chain Management (SCM) Major
GPA of 3.70 or greater

*Must participate in (4) Career & Professional Development sessions (60-75 minutes each).



Sophomores (Rising Juniors)

Declared SCM Major
B or better in Calculus
GPA 3.5+

*Must participate in 4 Career & Professional Development sessions (60-75 minutes each).

Juniors (Rising Seniors)

Declared SCM Major
Overall GPA 3.0 or better
B or better in Stats 201 and BA 242
B+ or better in BUAD 331

Must meet 1:1 w/ career staff & participate in (3) Career & Professional Development sessions (60-75 mins each).

Seniors (May / Dec Grads)

Declared SCM Major
B+ or better in SCM 310 or SCM 311 / SCM 312
Internship or Co-op required

*Must meet 1:1 w/ career staff & participate in (3) Career & Professional Development sessions (60-75 mins each).
